4. What does it mean to be entrepreneurial in everyday life?

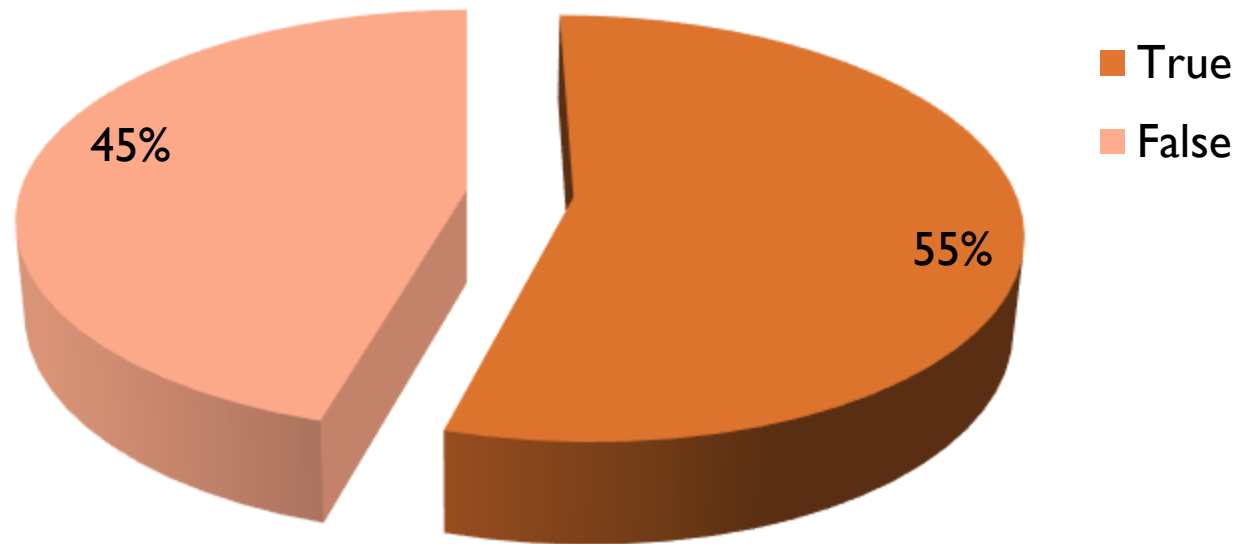

5. What are three main things you must think about before starting a business?

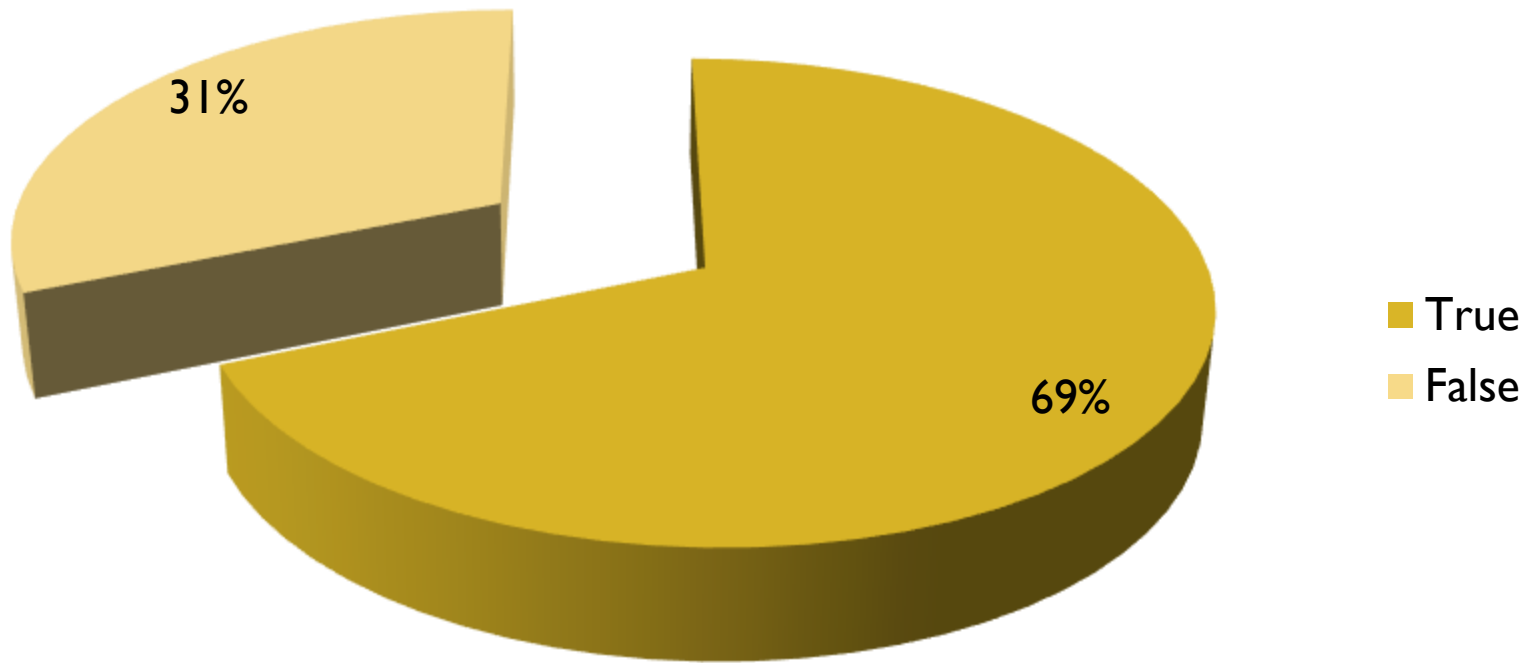
